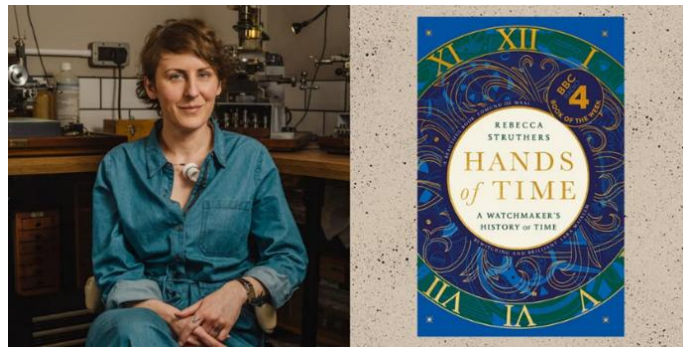


'Hands of Time' author, Dr Rebecca Struthers, to speak in Sydney in May 2025

Dr Rebecca Struthers is an English watchmaker, historian, author, engineer, gemmologist and a multi-award-winning designer, and will be in Sydney for a very special opportunity for all watch aficionados. The Watch and Clockmakers of Australia Inc. (WCA), the peak industry body for the professional and qualified Watch and Clockmaker repairers in Australia, is delighted to announce Dr Struthers will attend a Gala Cocktail Party in Sydney on Friday, 16th May 2025 at the Mercure Hotel. Rebecca will also be making a presentation about **The Art of Timekeeping: Crafting a Watch from Start to Finish**. Rebecca will also be accompanied by her husband and business partner Craig who is himself a master watchmaker. The Struthers are a British watchmaking duo who are renowned as some of the best of their generation.



Rebecca Struthers was born and raised in Birmingham in the UK and was just 17 when she set out on her path to becoming one of Britain's leading watchmakers. Initially training as a jeweller and silversmith with a passion for creating complex pieces of articulated jewellery, Rebecca soon found a way to combine her passion for craft with her love of science in the pursuit of horology. Her addiction to education has continued alongside her career as a watchmaker, historian and time doctor. In 2017, Rebecca Struthers became the first watchmaker in British history to earn a PhD in horology. Her book, '*Hands of Time: A Watchmaker's History of Time*', was released in 2023. The book was illustrated by her husband Craig. Limited copies of her publication will be available for purchase with an opportunity for it to be personally signed on the night.

C&R Struthers Watchmakers most recent collaboration was for Watches of Switzerland in the UK. This eminent, luxury watch retailer celebrated its centenary in 2024 and the company celebrated this milestone with a unique timepiece created by these independent British watchmakers, Rebecca and Craig Struthers. The watch features traditional craftsmanship and a modified Valjoux 90 movement. It is a tribute to the rich heritage of watchmaking and the partnership between retailers and manufacturers.
